Construction has begun...

Exciting news, on Tuesday, August 6th we broke ground on the construction of the new convenience store in Wabasso. This project is projected to be completed by July 1, 2025.

The construction will have different phases. By snow fall the goal is to have the building erected so that the inside work can be done during the winter months. Approximately March 15, 2025 will be when the old convenience store and the gas and diesel islands will be removed. During this period of time, the cardtrol located two blocks to the west will be utilized for gas and diesel purchases. You will need to have a cardtrol card to utilize this site. If weather cooperates the new store should be fully operational by July 1, 2025.

The cooperative will have a food truck set up for our customers to still get a select variety of products for your breakfast, lunch, and dinner needs during the final construction of the convenience store.
